Summary for 2017	
Kadampa Center Deficit for 2017	-\$21,100.00
Budget Shortfall at Raleigh	-\$47,500.00
Surplus for Light of the Path	\$26,400.00

- We depleted checking and savings by \$21,100 during the year, spent more than we received
- A surplus of \$26,400 at Light of the Path helped reduce the Raleigh shortfall of \$47,500
- We will not have Light of the Path to help our finances during 2018

Our Current Financial Situation

- Checking balance is about \$50,000
- Savings account has \$26,000
- Monthly expenses average \$22,000 so ~ 3.5 months
- Our "long-term development fund" at Vanguard has about \$4,000
- Credit card balances about \$6,000 owed
- Mortgage we owe \$64,000, pay \$22,300 per year



The 2018 Budget

- Had to raise our Annual Appeal request by 26% to balance the budget for 2018
- Now: Expected income \$255,400; expected expenses \$262,800
- Budget has expenses of \$7,400 greater than income, we must close this gap

Our Long-Term Financial Plans

- Try to balance income and expenses each year
- Welcome both volunteer work and financial contributions, they are both essential
- Wish List: Pay down or pay off our mortgage
- Wish List: Grow our long-term fund
- Accomplished: Started an IRA retirement plan for our four employees!
- Accomplished: Modest annual support for our three ordained nuns



Paying Off our Mortgage

- Two years ago, we owed First Citizens \$181,000 on our mortgage
- In June 2016, we took accumulated funds and paid in an extra \$72,000
- We received a \$5,000 bequest to pay down the mortgage
- Result: Mortgage balance is down to \$64,000, only 35 months of payments remain



Results of the 2018 Annual Appeal

- The 2018 Annual Appeal goal was \$177,000
- The goal was met! Pledges = \$177,000
- Now have 106 monthly supporters, 23 new this year
- Now have 96 one-time pledgers, 36 new this year
- Fifty-four supporters increased their pledge!
- Pledging will bring in 2/3 of our \$263,000 budget
- Supporter pledges are welcomed any time during the year
